

Students For Creative Anachronism of Auraria Campus.

The Students forming this group wish it to be known that they have created this constitution, and have adopted it for use in governing there actions as a Group.

This group formed on the Auraria campus, through the office of student life of Metropolitan State College of Denver shall be a chapter of the Society for Creative Anachronisms (SCA). The SCA is an international non-profit society geared toward the research and recreation of the middle ages.

To this end, we shall follow the laws, Traditions and customs of the Society, the Kingdom of the Outlands, and The Barony of Caerthe, Being where we our located. The exceptions shall occur when the rules of MSCD are in conflict, at which point we shall follow the rules and regulations of MSCD.

#### **Article One - Name**

The name of this group for College Purposes shall be Students For Creative Anachronism of Auraria Campus (SCA-AC).

The members of SCA-AC shall research and adopt a name and heraldry appropriate for our use, subject to the approval of the guidelines and acceptance process of the College of Heralds of the Kingdom of the Outlands.

#### **Article Two - Purpose**

The purpose of the SCA-AC is to research and recreate the Middle Ages in the Auraria Campus community by holding and traveling to events, demos and workshops.

#### **Article Three - Membership**

Membership is open to anyone associated with the Metropolitan State College of Denver, the University of Colorado at Denver, or the Community College of Denver.

#### **Article Four - Dues**

There will be no dues charged by the SCA-AC to be a member of the SCA-AC. However, you must be a member of the SCA to be an officer in the Society. Also there are non-member surcharges that the Board of directors dictates to be charged at all Official SCA events.

#### **Article Five - Officers**

All officers shall serve on the board. The board shall be responsible for establishing policies, overseeing events, and engaging in the daily operations of the SCA-AC. As stated above, Only paying members of the SCA may hold Office. In addition, According to MSCD guidelines only MSCD students are eligible to hold the offices of Seneschal, Deputy Seneschal, Exchequer, and Secretary. The Position of Secretary need not be a society member, and thus not be an SCA officer, but they are encouraged to do so. Any remaining Society positions may be filled by any members of the SCA-AC pending the approval of the group and the Seneschal.

*Seneschal (President)* - The Seneschal will preside over meetings and serve as the Chief Executive Officer of the SCA-AC. This person shall abide by all policies set forth for the Seneschal by the Kingdom of the Outlands.

*Deputy Seneschal (Vice President)* - This person will serve as Seneschal in the absence of the Seneschal.

*Exchequer (Treasurer)* - The Exchequer shall be responsible for all fiscal aspects of the SCA-AC. This person shall abide by all policies set forth by the guidelines of MSCD.

*Knight Marshal* - The Knight Marshal shall be responsible for all combat activities. This person shall abide by all policies set forth by the Knight Marshal of the Kingdom of the Outlands

*Minister of Arts and Sciences* - This person shall be responsible for all Arts and Science activities and shall abide by all policies set forth for the Minister of Arts and Sciences by the Kingdom of the Outlands.

*Rapier Marshal* - This person shall be responsible for all Rapier activities of the SCA-AC and shall abide by all policies set forth for the Rapier Marshal by the Kingdom of the Outlands.

*Herald* - This person will be responsible for all aspects of name and device submissions, announcements at events, and other duties as set forth by kingdom law.

**Article Six - Meetings**

Meetings shall take place monthly during the fall and spring sessions or as to be determined by the officers. Additionally, there shall be a yearly meeting to coincide as much as possible with May 1st to determine the officers for the upcoming year.

**Article Seven - Amendments**

This constitution may be amended or changed in any manner by a majority vote of all paid members.
